

Operational Flow Order (OFO)
June 22-26, 2017

In order to support system operations and maintain system integrity, DEO will be performing unscheduled maintenance. This will limit the ability of DEO to inject natural gas into storage, and in accordance DEO's tariffs, including sections 8 and 13 of its General Terms and Conditions of Transportation Service (GT&Cs), its Firm Storage Service (FSS) tariffs, and applicable provisions of its pooling service terms and conditions, the following restrictions will be effective Thursday, June 22, 2017 (gas day 22) through Monday, June 26, 2017 (gas day 26):

Suppliers and Customers shall restrict nominations for storage injection to 50% of the applicable maximum daily injection limit, as set forth in Customer's or Supplier's applicable pooling-service or storage-service contract.

For Suppliers and Customers who wish to make nominations for storage injection in excess of these restrictions, the excess portion may only be supplied via the Tennessee Gas Pipeline Gilmore receipt point (Meter # 420934).

For all daily-balanced customers and supplier pools, supply nominations shall not exceed usage each day. Daily-balanced customers and supplier pools include Daily Transportation Service end users and all Energy Choice related pools, including those serving Standard Service Offer, Standard Choice Offer, Monthly Variable Rate, and Energy Choice accounts. Suppliers are expected to decrease or maintain supply nominations and not reallocate supplies to monthly-balanced accounts or pools to meet daily-balanced customer requirements. DEO may also contact monthly-balanced pool operators if it determines that the supplier has excess supplies nominated to DEO's system.

DEO may extend this OFO, if necessary, based on future operating conditions. This OFO does not apply to supplier pools or customers in the West Ohio division.

Pursuant to the applicable provisions of DEO's GTCs and its pooling service terms and conditions, failure to comply with an OFO may result in the imposition of additional charges by DEO and the exercise of other remedies. Details regarding the calculation of OFO-related charges and costs and other remedies may be found in DEO's tariffs.
