

The Operational Flow Order (OFO) that was posted yesterday for Wednesday, December 27, 2017 (gas day 27) and Thursday, December 28, 2017 (gas day 28) will be in effect.

Based on its most recent weather forecast, Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) currently projects that nominations to its Maumee receipt points from ANR and Panhandle Eastern Pipeline may not be sufficient to meet anticipated customer requirements for Saturday, December 30, 2017 (gas day 30) through Tuesday, January 2, 2018 (gas day 2).

DEO is posting this Operational Advisory to inform customers and suppliers that they may be required to adjust Maumee deliveries in accordance with DEO's General Terms and Conditions of Transportation Service and provisions set forth in the Maumee Delivery Point Requirements document posted on the EBB.

DEO will be contacting shippers with gas scheduled to Maumee to determine whether they can increase supplies to that point and will inform affected customers and suppliers of their currently estimated pro rata share of Maumee requirements for December 30, 2017 (gas day 30) through January 2, 2018 (gas day 2).

DEO will continue to post updated information regarding the status of Maumee deliveries and may adjust requirements based on updated information. Please note that a lack of voluntary compliance by customers and suppliers may result in the issuance of a receipt-point specific Operational Flow Order.
