

OPERATIONAL FLOW ORDER DECEMBER 27, 2017 THROUGH JANUARY 6, 2018 SUPPLEMENTAL POSTING #2

Dominion Energy Ohio's (DEO) Operational Flow Order (OFO) that has been in effect since Wednesday, December 27, 2017 (gas day 27), has been extended through Saturday, January 6, 2018 (gas day 6).

At this time, the OFO is limited to securing appropriate volumes at DEO's Maumee interconnections with ANR and Panhandle Eastern pipelines throughout this OFO period. Daily Maumee requirements are posted in DekaFlow and are based on anticipated average daily temperatures in the 0F to 15F range. Please note, however, that January 4-6, 2018 (gas days 4-6) are trending very close to a 0F average temperature which would increase the Maumee supply requirements. We are watching this closely and will post additional notice should the lower temperature threshold materialize.

Daily-balanced customers and supplier pools are expected to match daily supply with daily usage each day. As stated previously DEO may issue a system-wide OFO if it determines that supplies nominated to daily-balanced accounts or pools are not sufficient to meet anticipated daily requirements or that supplies nominated to monthly-balanced accounts or pools are being improperly redirected or are otherwise insufficient to support system operations and maintain system integrity.

DEO will continue to post updated information as needed and may adjust requirements based on operating conditions.
