

NOTICE OF IMPENDING SUPPLY RESTRICTIONS AND REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY RESTRICTIONS  
February 4 ? 5, 2018

In order to support system operations and maintain system integrity and to permit the performance of mandatory unscheduled main Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) has determined that it will be necessary to impose significant restrictions on the receipt of natural gas from Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI) beginning Tuesday, February 6, 2018 (gas day 6) and continuing until further notice. Additional restrictions will be implemented in Dekaflow as soon as practicable.

In the interim, effective Sunday, February 4, and Monday, February 5, 2018 (gas days 4 & 5), DEO requests that Suppliers and Customers take the following actions to support system operations and maintain system integrity:

- ? Reduce receipt nominations from DETI
- ? Nominate replacement supplies:
  - o to the ANR Pipeline (meter 108641) and Panhandle Eastern (meter EOHIO) Maumee receipt points and to Tennessee Gas Pipeline (meter 420934) and/or Petersburg (meter 420932) receipt points; and/or
  - o via increased storage withdrawals, subject to any applicable limitations

Although, at this time, DEO is not issuing any requests with respect to the following Local Production Pooling Service (LPPS) meters: all Blue Racer Midstream meters; Eureka Midstream Mullet), DEO expects that nominations from these meters may also be subject to restrictions beginning gas day 6.

DEO may issue additional requests or impose additional restrictions if necessary based on future operating conditions. For more information, please view at:
