

SUBJECT: OPERATIONAL ADVISORY
EFFECTIVE: July, 2018

Due to compliance related maintenance, Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) may be required to take out of service a major transmission line with less than 24 hours advance notice during the last 2 weeks of July, 2018. We will have further information on the potential for this maintenance on July 13, 2018.

This Advisory describes certain limitations and restrictions that MAY be necessary should DEO need to take this pipeline out of service:

- * Storage injections will be limited to a maximum of 50% of the maximum daily injection quantity (MDIQ).
- * Additionally, a portion of current supply from Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI), Texas Eastern Pipeline, and/or any of the UTICA LPPS connections may need to be replaced with Tennessee Gas Pipeline deliveries at the Gilmore receipt point (meter# 420934) and/or ANR Pipeline (meter# 108641) or Panhandle Eastern Pipeline (meter #EOHIO) (Maumee Receipt point).

DEO will endeavor to provide further notice and information as soon as it is able, but due to the timing requirements associated with the underlying compliance activities, the maximum advance notice for these restrictions will be 24 hours should an outage be necessary.

Depending on operating conditions, additional limitations and restrictions may be necessary.
