

Topic: OPERATIONAL ADVISORY

Effective: September 24-28, 2018

For the period September 24-28, 2018, Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI) will be performing maintenance on its pipeline require taking one or more of the Dominion Energy Ohio (DEO) receipt points out of service.

Due to this maintenance and depending on operational conditions, DEO will likely need to limit nominations to the DETI/DEO city. If nominations at the DETI/DEO city-gate are limited, DEO will not be able to approve increases at Local Production Pooling Service receipt points or from the Texas Eastern Transmission Company (TETCO) Clarington receipt point. Additionally, DEO will likely limit injections by as much as 50% of MDIQ during the maintenance period.

Additional Tennessee Gas Pipeline (TGP) Gilmore and/or ANR Pipeline or Panhandle Eastern Pipeline (Maumee) gate space is expected available during this maintenance period. If DETI, LPPS and TETCO nominations exceed DEO's operational capacity, DEO may be required to allocate volumes across shippers and/or issue restrictions to ensure safe and reliable service.

DEO will issue additional guidance as appropriate if it is necessary to limit nominations as discussed above.
