

SUBJECT: OPERATIONAL ADVISORY - VOLUNTARY REDUCTIONS

EFFECTIVE: October 15-17, 2019 (Gas Days 15-17)

Due to system maintenance within Dominion Energy Ohio's (DEO's) storage field, DEO is requesting that all suppliers and end-users with storage service, voluntarily reduce storage injections for the period Tuesday, October 15 through Thursday, October 17, 2019 (Gas Days 15-17). DEO will not approve any over-injection requests during this period. DEO reserves the right to impose limitations and/or make cuts should it become necessary to ensure system reliability.

In addition, as previously posted, DEO requests that all suppliers and end-users take whatever steps necessary to ensure that supply and demand are in balance during the Operational Advisory and for the upcoming weekend. Although suppliers and end-users bear ultimate responsibility to balance supply and demand, DEO will be monitoring nominations closely and, if necessary, will reduce or reject nominations in accordance with Section 8.3 of the General Terms and Conditions of Transportation of Service (GTC) and Section 8.4 of the General Terms and Conditions of Energy Choice Pooling Service (ECPS).

DEO reserves the right to take further action in accordance with DEO's General Terms and Conditions of Transportation and Pooling Service and other applicable tariff provisions, including the issuance of system-wide, point-specific, or supplier-specific operational flow orders and limitation of storage injections.
