

Energy Choice Storage Noms for Future Months

Do not enter zero placeholder storage noms for future months in DEO Dekaflow. It is OK to enter the following month noms once the Demand and Capacity have been updated from zero to actual Demand and Capacity in the Contracts module for that month.

Example 1: It is OK to enter May 2020 storage noms because Contracts Demand/Capacity/MSIQ have been updated and are no longer zero.

Example 2: It is not OK to enter June 2020 or future storage noms. Contract Demand/Capacity/MSIQ are zero for June forward. Noms will cut any nom QTY that is entered for June forward to zero. **If you nom a zero placeholder for June forward, the allocations process that creates storage balances will pick up that zero nom as an actual nom and allocate a storage balance through the end date of that zero nom. The next time you enter and save a nom in a current month (month with actual Demand and Capacity), you will receive a nom save error because the nom exceeds a future month's capacity.
