

SUBJECT: OPERATIONAL ADVISORY ? Upstream Pipeline Maintenance
EFFECTIVE: July 6-12, 2020

For the period July 6-12, 2020, Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI) will be performing system maintenance requiring the shut-in of the Gilmore receipt point. On these dates, DEO DOES NOT CURRENTLY anticipate having to restrict DETI receipts or storage injections based on current supply nominations and system operations; however, this maintenance MAY impact DEO's storage injection volumes if supply nominations increase or system operations change.

If DETI nominations exceed DEO's reduced operational capacity during this maintenance, DEO may be required to allocate volumes across shippers, issue restrictions, and/or take other actions to ensure safe and reliable service to maintain the integrity of the system.

DEO will issue additional guidance as appropriate if DEO deems necessary to limit nominations as discussed above. Please direct any questions to EOG_Trans_Serv@dominionenergy.com.
